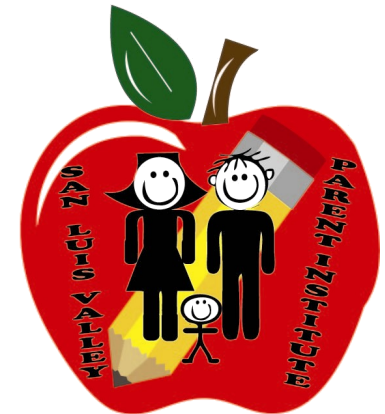

WhyTry

Christian Moore is an internationally renowned author, speaker, licensed clinical social worker, and advocate for at-risk youth. Coming from a blended family of 12 children, Christian spent most of his childhood years on the streets. In a neighborhood just outside of Washington, D.C., he was exposed to a wide array of social problems. At an early age, Christian had been diagnosed with Attention Deficit-Hyperactivity Disorder, conduct disorder, and severe learning disabilities. Because of these setbacks, he often felt socially isolated in school. He spent time both as bully and victim; and often acted out to avoid answering the questions of teachers. Counselors informed Christian that college was not a viable option. He volunteered in the inner city after graduation, which gave him a drive to help others and a reason to try. Christian rose from a "troubled" special education student to a well-respected recipient of a master's degree in social work. Christian created WhyTry stemming from his personal challenges through life. Christian's personal mission is to ensure that youth are given an opportunity to succeed, regardless of social or economic status, race, background, or other personal obstacles.
